SUMMARY:

A left lower leg and foot plus two bones from the top and bottom of the spine and the left half of a pelvis, probably from different people. They were all completely skeletonized, with no soft tissue remaining.

From anthropology examination the leg was from an adult i.e. someone over 17 but it was not possible to say whether male or female. The pelvis appeared to be from someone else - a young man below the age of 22.

The only injury present was a fracture of the fibula below the knee, but this probably occurred post mortem from moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in these persons.
