AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

Two portions of skull bone from the top of the head with a little light brown hair still adherent.

From anthropology examination these were from an adult, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The skull was clearly fractured with only the top part remaining. There were no specific features such as gunshot defects in the portion remaining, and it is thus difficult to know what caused the fractures or whether they occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 375BP was:

Unascertained
