SUMMARY:

A right lower leg and part of the ankle and foot, largely skeletonized apart from some tissue still attached to the foot.

From anthropology examination the leg was from an adult, aged over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

Both leg bones were fractured below the knee but most likely this occurred after death from moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 380BP was:

Unascertained
