AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

A left ankle and foot still in a shoe, with the lower end of the shin bone also present. There was still some soft tissue surviving but the remains were otherwise skeletonized.

From anthropology examination the foot was from an adult, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The lower end of the shin bone was fractured but as the rest of the bone was missing it was difficult to know what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 386BP** was:

Unascertained
