AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

These were the saponified remains of an almost complete body. The left upper limb had a cotton strip ligature around it.

The person was male, and from anthropological data measured 161.6 +/- 7.8 cms. in height.

He had been shot in the right pelvis, as seen by fractures of the pelvic bones and the presence of metal bullet core fragments. With such a gunshot injury it is highly likely that there would have been associated internal damage or complications.

He died from the injury he received.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 397B** was: Firearm injury to the trunk

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
