AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

A complete skull together with the lower jaw and part of the uppermost bone in the spine, totally skeletonized.

From anthropology examination, the skull was from a male adult i.e. someone over the age of 17, but it was not possible to determine anything further.

There were fractures of both the top and base of the skull and of the lower jaw but these had the appearance of injuries caused after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 409BP** was: **Unascertained**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
