## AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

**CASE NO:** KK3 416B

**AUTOPSY DATE:** 04.08.99

**MORTUARY:** Visoko

### SUMMARY:

A partially skeletonized body, almost complete. There were saponified and mummified soft tissues still adherent to the trunk and limbs.

From the anthropological data, the person was male aged 31 – 60 and measured 171.8 +/- 7.7 cm.

The man had been shot in the head, the face bones partially shattered and <sup>here</sup> were two exit holes in the cranial vault.

The other fractures, were post-mortal accident.

The man died for the injuries he received.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 416B** was:  
**Gunshot wound to the head.**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
