## SUMMARY:

A partially skeletonized body, almost complete. There were saponified and mummified soft tissues still adherent to the trunk and limbs.

From the anthropological data, the person was male aged 31 - 60 and measured 171.8 + 1.7 cm.

The man had been shot in the head, the face bones partially shattered and were two exit hole in the cranial yault.

The other fractures, were post-mortal accident.

The man died for the injuries he received.

## CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 416B** was: **Gunshot wound to the head.** 

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
