SUMMARY:

Partly skeletonized human remains with no significant amount of external or internal soft tissue attached to it.

Sex is determined as male, age is 31 – 71 years and stature is 173.6 +/- 7.7 cm. from anthropological data. A fatal, high velocity type firearm injury found in the chest in left side probably inflicted from behind. There was another bullet injury to the right foot.

The compressed-type comminuted fracture found in the skull appears to be a post mortem injury probably due to compression or crushing of the body after death.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 417B** was:

Firearm injury to the chest
