AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

SUMMARY:

These were deeply saponified remains of an almost complete body. The lower right side of the chest had several metal fragments in, and there were fractures of 3 ribs (6th, 7th, 8th).

From the anthropological data the person was male, aged 31-71 years old, and measured 161.8 +/- 7.8 in height.

He had been shot in the right and left chest half, as seen by comminuted fractures of the ribs and several bullet's fragments which were lodged in the soft tissues of the "foci". With such a gunshot injury it is highly likely, that there would have been associated internal damage or complications.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 443B was:

Bullet wounds to the trunk

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
