## AUTOPSY REPORT

### SUMMARY:

An almost complete body. There still was some adipoceros-mummified tissues adherent to the lower trunk.

The person was male, and from the anthropological data he was 35 – 75 years old, he measured 176.7 +/- 7.7 cm.

He had received a substantial injury to his face, causing fractures of his upper facial bones involving the nose, the temporal, the zygomatic and maxilla. This could have been the result of stamping, or a severe blow from some heavy object. There was also a fracture of the right radius at its upper third.

Despite the clear evidence of blunt force trauma, it was difficult to say whether this occurred before or after death.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 448B** was:

**Unascertained**
