AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

Fragments of a skull minus the lower jaw and most of the bones of the face. There was still some firm brain tissue adherent.

From anthropology examination, the skull was from a male adult, but it was not possible to determine anything further.

The skull from which the fragments came was clearly extensively fractured. The portions remaining showed no specific features such as gunshot injury and it is thus difficult to say what caused the damage or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings, and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 337BP** was:

Unascertained
