## **SUMMARY:**

Three fragments of skull with some dried brain tissue still attached.

From anthropology examination, it was not possible to determine anything from them in terms of age of the person or whether male or female.

The skull was clearly fractured but as most of it was missing, it was difficult to say what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 195BP** was: **Unascertained**
