AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

A complete pelvis including the sacrum and a few vertebrae from the lower part of the spine. There were no soft tissues remaining.

From anthropology examination, the pelvis was from an adult man, aged between 17 and 71 but it was not possible to determine anything further.

There were fractures of the left side of the pelvis but most likely this occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 196BP** was: **Unascertained**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
