SUMMARY:

The bones of a right arm but minus the hand. There were no soft tissues remaining.

From anthropology examination, the arm was from an adult i.e. someone over the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

One of the forearm bones was fractured near its lower end, with the lower part missing, but it was difficult to say what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

Unascertained
