SUMMARY:

A left foot minus the ankle bones, still in a sock and boot, and still with some soft tissue attached.

From anthropology examination, the foot was from an adult, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

There were no injuries and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 200BP** was: **Unascertained**
