AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

MORTUARY: Visoko

SUMMARY:

There were deep saponified remains of a body, almost complete. The trunk and limbs were disarticulated and dislocated from the anatomical position.

From the anthropological data the person was male, aged 16-19 years old, and measured 172.5 +/- 7.7 cms in height.

He had been shot in the left mid-lateral part of the back, as seen by the fractures of the vertebral bodies. With such gunshot injury it is highly likely that there would have been associated internal damage or complications.

He died from the injury he received.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 221B was: Firearm injury to the trunk

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
