AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

Pieces of a skull together with the lower jaw and the upper two bones of the neck, the remains being largely skeletonized though with some soft material still attached in places.

From anthropology examination the skull was from an adult male, though it was not possible to determine anything further.

The skull was in fragments with much of it missing, and while the fracturing of the parts remaining showed some features of high velocity gunshot injury, this could not be proved. One of the neck bones was also fractured.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 229BP was:

Unascertained
