## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

## **SUMMARY:**

These were partially skeletonized remains of a body almost complete. The skull was shattered.

From the anthropological data the person was male, aged 31-71 years old, and measured 178.5 +/- 7.7 cm in height.

The autopsy revealed evidence of him being shot twice. A bullet would appear to have passed across the cranial vault, fracturing it. A second bullet had penetrated the right upper chest, fracturing the right scapula and the 6<sup>th</sup> rib.

The man died from the injuries he received

## CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 243B was:

Gunshot wounds of head and trunk
