SUMMARY:

These were the remains of a complete body, partially saponified and mummified. The upper limbs were tied up by a ligature.

From the anthropological data the person was male, and aged 31-71, and measured 173 +/-7.7cm in height.

There were no injuries or other findings.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 266B was:

Unascertained
