AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

SUMMARY:

These skeletal remains consisted of only parts of the body of a male. The head and neck were absent and, apart form the bones of the left hand, the left upper limb was also missing.

No apparent ante mortem injuries were identified and a fracture of the right forearm bone had probably been sustained after death. In view of the absence of injuries and since no fragments were identified on x-ray, it would seem appropriate to conclude that the cause of death was unascertained.

A significant finding was the presence of a ligature from the bones of the right hand.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 280B** was: **Unascertained**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
