SUMMARY:

The bones of a right leg and foot with no soft tissues attached, together with a single left rib.

From anthropology examination, the leg was from an adult i.e. someone over 17 but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

The femur was fractured in its middle third but the lower part was missing and so it is difficult to say what caused this or whether it occurred before or after death.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 285BP** was:

Unascertained
