## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

## SUMMARY:

A right lower leg and foot, the former skeletonized but the foot still with soft tissue attached.

From anthropology examination the remains were from an adult i.e. someone over 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

Both leg bones were fractured in their middle parts, but this could well have occurred after death from crushing or moving of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination, it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 286BP** was:
