SUMMARY:

These were deeply saponified remains of an almost complete body. The skull was shattered.

From the anthropological data the person was male, aged from 31 to 71 and measuring 176.4 +/- 7.7-cm height.

He would appear to have died from a gunshot injury to the head, which had caused the complete fragmentation of the cranium vault, very typical of the high velocity rifle injury. The bullet had struck the cranial bones at the right side of the frontal bone.

He died from the injuries he received

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 327B** was: **Gunshot wound of head**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
