AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

SUMMARY:

A complete body except for some small bones of the feet. The body was in advanced decomposition with mummified parts. When found it was blindfolded and both wrists were bound at the body back. From external soft tissue examination the sex was determined as male

From anthropology data the age was determined as ranging between 25 – 45 years and the stature estimated as 190.8 +/- 7.8 cm.

There was a gunshot injury to the chest as shown by a skin wound in the lower right chest and a recovered bullet from the opposite left side of the chest cavity. There was another bullet recovered from the upper abdomen and also a third gunshot injury to the left leg causing fragmentation of the left tibia. Any of the previously described gunshot injuries can be potentially fatal.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 501B** was:

Multiple gunshot injuries to the chest, abdomen and left leg

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
