SUMMARY:

The lower half of a body only - the left side of the pelvis and both legs - with the tissues almost completely skeletonized.

As established from anthropology data, the person was male, aged between 31 and 71, and measured from 170 to 185 cms in height. There were no particular identifying features.

The only injury present was a fracture of one of the bones of the left shin, but most likely this occurred after death from crushing or moving the body.

There were no gunshot injuries and no other findings, and so the cause of death in this person, from this examination, remains unascertained.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 502BP was: Unascertained
