SUMMARY:

These focally mummified saponified remains were received with the hands tied behind the back by ligature, probably ante mortem.

The person was a male, was established by anthropological data to be between 31 and 63 years of age and about 174 cm tall. The head hair was straight and brown, but there were no other identifying features.

Autopsy revealed a single gunshot wound to the chest, passing from front to back and right to left, through a region of vital structures.

There were also bilateral rib and mid pelvic fractures consistent with post mortem crush injury.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 508B was:

Gunshot wound to the chest
