## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

## **SUMMARY:**

Saponified and skeletonized body with blindfold. According to soft tissue and anthropology determination the person was male one. From anthropology data the height estimation was 168.3 + 1 - 7.7 cm and age range 31 - 71 years. Colour of hair was not possible to state. Right ulna and radius were missing. In right sleeve of shirt was tied.

There were gunshot injuries:

- in the skull: in the right frontal bone was an entrance-exit wound and right side of the skull bone defects
- Left side of the skull was undamaged
- A fracture in the right humerus, probably a gunshot injury, but a crush injury cannot be excluded

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 536B was:

Gunshot injury at the skull
