## AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

**CASE NO:** KK3 536B

**AUTOPSY DATE:** 02.09.99

### SUMMARY:

Saponified and skeletonized body with blindfold. According to soft tissue and anthropology determination the person was male one. From anthropology data the height estimation was 168.3 +/- 7.7 cm and age range 31 – 71 years. Colour of hair was not possible to state. Right ulna and radius were missing. In right sleeve of shirt was tied.

There were gunshot injuries:

- in the skull: in the right frontal bone was an entrance-exit wound and right side of the skull bone defects
- Left side of the skull was undamaged
- A fracture in the right humerus, probably a gunshot injury, but a crush injury cannot be excluded

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 536B** was:

**Gunshot injury at the skull**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
