## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

## SUMMARY:

This was a skeletonized and saponified body of a male. According to anthropologist measurements the height estimate was 183.7 +/- 7.7 cm and age range 19 – 29 years. Hair was black and short.

Body was not complete. Lower parts of the both lower limbs were missing same areas were also missing from the legs of trousers. There were no fractures in the distal parts of femurs.

There were ligatures on hands.

There were two gunshot injury areas:

- In the region of chest. There were fractures in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> thoracic vertebras. In 10<sup>th</sup> left rib were a bullet hole, 8 mm in diameter. There were also bullets in chest and thoracic vertebra.
- In the region at right femur

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 544BP was:

Gunshot, chest and right leg injuries
