This was almost a complete male body, partly skeletonized and moderately saponified.

From anthropological data, height estimation is 161.3 +/- 7.7 cm, age range 31-71 years. Hair was black and short.

There were three main injury locations:

- a shot injury in the area of left thoracic cavity
- two fractures in mandible
- a shotgun injury in the right humerus

A whole bullet in the left foot without any injuries in the leg.

In fluoroscopy, there were fragments of bullets in skull, right humerus and chest.

Probably post mortal fractures in the ribs and pelvis.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 569B** was:

Gunshot injury into the left chest and right humerus

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
