AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

A complete, totally skeletonized human remains with some additional bones (from another individual).

Entrance hole in left temporal area with internal bevelling and radiating fractures. It suggests that the cause of death was gunshot injury to the head. There are also some bullets found elsewhere around the body. There were fractures of the ribs and right scapula. They may well have occurred post mortem, from crushing and/or moving the body.

As established from anthropology data, the person was male, aged between 14 and 19 years, and measured about 181.5 +/- 7.7 cms in height. There were no particular identifying features.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 629B** was: **Gunshot injury to the head**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings
