AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

These were almost totally skeletonized, complete remains with multiple fractures of the skull. Neither ligature nor blindfold has been found.

Anthropology examination has revealed that it was male aged 17-25 and about 175 +/- 7.7 cm in stature.

The presence of multiple fractures of the skull suggests that the cause of death was head injury (small metal parts have been found on x-ray).

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 658B** was: **Gunshot injury to the head**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
