SUMMARY:

A right upper arm and shoulder blade, completely skeletonized.

From anthropology examination the remains were from an adult, over the age of 17, but it was not possible to say whether male or female or to determine anything further.

There was a small fresh defect near the lower end of the shoulder blade but what caused this and whether it occurred before or after death is difficult to say.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 672BP was:

Unascertained
