AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

MORTUARY: Visoko

SUMMARY:

A partly skeletonized body of a young man (boy), aged 14-18 years. Stature could not be calculated. The hair was brown. In arms was ligature, diameter approx. 8 mm.

In the skull were entrance-exit wounds in the right temporal region. Frontal and facial bones were fractured. A part of mandible was missing. The back of the skull was undamaged.

The chest had bullet fragments, but the region showed no definite ante mortem injuries. A lot of other areas, except skull, showed no injuries.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 673B was:

Gunshot injury in the head

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
