AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

These were the remains of an almost complete, deeply saponified, body. The trunk and the limbs were still covered by pultaceous tissue, the lower limbs tissue was mummified. The person was male.

From the anthropological data the man was aged 31 – 71 years old.

He had been shot in the upper third of the left thigh, as seen by a communited fracture of the femur neck with bullet fragments lodged in the surrounding tissues. The right femur neck was fractured probably in the peri mortal period.

He died from the injuries he received

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 674B was:

Firearm injuries of the lower left limb

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
