AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

SUMMARY:

These were partially skeletonized remains of a complete body. The upper limbs were tied at the back by a ligature. The person was male.

From the anthropological data he was aged 31-71 years old and measured 167.6 +/- 7.7 cm. in height. He had been shot several times: in the right chest, in the pelvis, in the right elbow joint and in the left lower limb, each of these with residual metal fragments still present.

With such injuries it is highly likely that there would have been associated internal damages or complications.

He died from the injuries he received

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 678B** was: Firearm injuries to the face, chest and lower left limb

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
