AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

SUMMARY:

These were deeply saponified remains of an almost complete body. The upper limbs were tied up at the back by a cotton double ligature.

The person was male. From the anthropological data the man was 31 – 60 years old and measured 173.2 +/- 7.7 cm.

He had been shot in the right pelvis, as seen by a comminuted fracture of the left pubic bone and by bullet fragments in the soft tissues around the neck of the left femur.

With such a gunshot injury it is highly likely that there would have been associated internal damage or complications.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 719B** was:
Firearm injury to the trunk

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
