AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

SUMMARY:

A complete body except for some small bones of the left hand. The body was almost completely skeletonized with some attached soft tissue showing mummification. It was partly clothed.

From anthropology data the body was of a male whose age ranged between 31 - 60 years and stature was estimated as 170.2 + 1/2 + 7.7 cm. There were no specific characteristic features present.

Examination of the skeletal remains revealed rib fractures at both sides, fracture of the left forearm bones, in addition to fracture of the right leg. However, it was not possible to confirm that any of such fractures were ante mortem in nature.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 724B** was: **Unascertained**

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
