SUMMARY:

A complete and largely intact skull with the lower jaw and the top two bones of the neck. The brain was still present inside but otherwise the tissues were completely skeletonized.

As established from anthropology examination the remains were from a male adult, but it was not possible to determine anything further.

There was fracturing of the bones of the face but this probably occurred after death from crushing of the body.

There were no other findings and from this examination it is not possible to determine the cause of death in this person.
