SUMMARY:

These saponified and mummified remains were received with the chest partially flattened and deformed into a pseudokyphoscoliosis.

This man was established, by anthropological data to be between 31 and 65 years of age and have a stature of about 182 cm. There was grey-brown hair, but no other identifying features were found.

Autopsy established the presence of two gunshot wounds, one to the back of the head, passing from back to front and right to left through the region of the brain. The other was a gunshot wound to the right leg with fracture of the fibula.

In addition, there were bilateral rib fractures, probably indicative of crushing of the body after death.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 755B was:

Gunshot wound to the head

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
