AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

Complete, partly skeletonized and saponified human remains.

As established from anthropology data, the person was male, aged between 31-65, and measured about 179.7 +/- 7.7 cms in height. There was no particular identifying features.

Four holes in the skull have been found. Three of them had internal and one external bevelling. Also a bullet was present inside the skull.

Apart from that, metal parts found inside the trunk suggest that this individual was also injured by trunk gunshot.

Fractures of the right hand was probably caused by another gunshot.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 788B was:

Gunshot injuries of the chest

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings
