## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

## SUMMARY:

A complete body which was showing partial skeletonization with most of the soft tissue preserved and saponified. The body was partly clothed. External soft tissue examination showed it was of a male.

Anthropology data confirmed that the body was of a male whose age ranged between 31 and 71 and stature estimated as 181 +/- 7.7 cm.

There were gunshot injuries to the chest with two bullets recovered from there and also shown radiologically, and in addition there was extensive fragmentation of the scapula and multiple fractured right ribs.

The multiple fractured left ribs, on the other hand, were most probably post mortem in nature.

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 817B was:

Gunshot injuries to the chest

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
