AUTOPSY REPORT

SUMMARY:

These saponified complete remains were received with the hands and wrists bound behind the back by a cloth ligature. This is consistent with ante mortem ligature.

Anthropological data established that the person was a man between 31 and 60 years of age, having a stature of about 167 cm. No other identifying features were noted.

Autopsy revealed a gunshot wound of the cranium which entered in the left back side of the head and passed from back to front. It passed through the region of the brain.

Also present were bilateral rib and right pelvic fractures, indicative of crushing of the body after death.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 818B was:

Gunshot wound to the head

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
