## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

## **SUMMARY:**

These were partially skeletonized and saponified remains. Large areas of skin were preserved.

One keyhole in the skull was found with radiating fractures.

On external examination it was found that the person was male.

He was 31 - 65 years old and about 169.0 + /- 7.7 cm in stature. Keyhole found in the skull shows that the cause of death was gunshot injury to the head.

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 916B was:

Gunshot injury to the head
