## **AUTOPSY REPORT**

## SUMMARY:

Complete human remains, saponified. No blindfold. The cloth ligature was found around right wrist, which suggests the person was tied up before death.

On external examination it was found that this person was male. As established from anthropology data he was aged 31 to 60 and measured 181.5 +/- 7.7 cms in height.

Rib fractures may well have occurred post mortem from moving or crushing the body. There was no other body damage, although one metal fragment was seen on x-ray, and so the cause of death, in this person from this examination, remains unascertained.

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK3 945B** was: **Unascertained** 

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination. Both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.
