SUMMARY:

This was a partly skeletonized body, soft tissue damages was in left shoulder and abdominal part of the trunk both front and back.

According to soft tissue determination this was a man, from anthropology measurements the height estimate was 175.7 +/- 7.7, and age range 31 – 65 years. The height from body was 176 cm. Hair was black and there was also a short black beard. In left shoulder were fragments of bullet. There were in same region fractures 1st - 7th left ribs, clavicle and scapula, which are suitable for gunshot injures. It is also possible that left ulna-radius fractures are in relation to chest injuries.

No other injury areas could to be ascertained as ante mortem injuries.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 946B was:

Gunshot injury in the chest
