SUMMARY:

Complete human remains, saponified. Either ligature or blindfold was found.

During external examination it was found that this person was male. As estimated from anthropology data, this person was aged between 31 and 60, and measured 173.2 +/- 7.7 cms in height.

Rib fractures may well have occurred after death from crushing and/or moving the body. Three bullets were found inside the body (abdomen, pelvis and right knee) but no fracture was found. This suggests that these bullets were shot with low velocity.

The cause of death in this person was probably these gunshot injuries to the trunk.

CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number KK3 1012B was:

Gunshot injuries to the trunk
