## SUMMARY:

The upper half of a body including the skull and the arms, but not the pelvis. The remains were totally skeletonized, with no soft tissue remaining whatever and no clothing.

From anthropology data, the person was male, and aged between 20 and 63, but it was not possible to estimate his height. There were no particular identifying features.

There were fractures of the skull and the right upper arm bone. The former was probably post mortem in nature from crushing or moving the body. The latter may or may not have been similar or caused by some form of trauma before death. There were no particular features of gunshot injury.

From this estimation, the cause of death in this person remains unascertained.

## **CAUSE OF DEATH:**

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK2 001BP** was: **Unascertained**
