## AUTOPSY REPORT

KOZLUK GRAVE SITE

### SUMMARY:

Small parts of a body only – the left side of the face, the lower jaw and four neck bones, with no soft tissues attached.

The remains were from an adult person but it was not possible to say whether male or female. There were no identifying characteristics.

The skull was clearly fragmented but the portion remaining showed no specific fractures, such as gunshot injury etc.

There were no other significant findings and so the cause of death in this person, from this examination, remains unascertained.

### CAUSE OF DEATH:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **KK2 024BP** was:  
**Unascertained**
